Prof Jurgen Tautz

One of the world's leading bee scientists and winner of many awards for communicating with the public about his work. Developed HOBOS - Honeybee Online Studies - with live images from deep inside beehives.

President of Apimondia, the world beekeeping body. His major concerns are stopping the global decline in our bee population, the overuse of chemicals, and developing beekeeping enterprises to fight poverty in poor countries.



Prof. Robert Paxton

Head of a group studying bee biology and their parasites at the University of Halle, in Germany. Using his latest ongoing research, he explores how much deformed wing virus is responsible for the increased demise of colonies over winter.

Runs a family commercial beekeeping business and teaches for the BBKA. Famed for knowing how to "read bees", he explains how better observation will help us to understand and predict what our colonies are going to do next.
